School begins at 8.50am and ends at 3.15pm. Children are able to arrive at school at 8.30am and will be supervised on the playground until they are admitted into class at 8.45am.

### **Our OFSTED inspection (May 2014) stated that:**

*'The headteacher, other leaders and governors have worked effectively to raise standards. They have a clear understanding of what needs to be done to further improve teaching and learning. Pupils in all years achieve well and are making good progress from their different starting points.'*

### **Data**

National end of year expectations for the new national curriculum (2014) have been significantly raised in all areas. With a new curriculum, new assessment arrangements were introduced with the government removing a system of levels and replacing it with a system of met or not met end of key stage 1 / 2 expectations. This is very different from the previous 'best fit' model and has resulted in some children who struggle in only one area being judged as 'not met'. The Government has been clear in explaining that 'as this is the first year of the new assessments the results will look different from those of previous years and cannot be compared with them directly'.

Please note: all our data includes our children from our special needs centre. When excluded our data increases by 4-5%. Our data analysis shows that Eastwick Schools continue to be in line or above the national data in all areas.
