Nature of support

During the academic year 2015/2016 (September 2015 to July 2016) support given and planned for which is funded by the Sports Premium is as follows:

Curriculum focus of Sports Premium spending

- Teachers to observe 'lead teacher' gleaning ideas and informing their own teaching.
- To inspire the children to enjoy PE lessons and give them challenge to improve their practice.
