



## JUNIOR SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

### SCHOOL UNIFORM

Eastwick is a school that wears a school uniform with pride and it is important that children should maintain a smart appearance. The predominant school colour is dark green and we ask for parents' co-operation in the maintenance of our uniform policy and the Headteacher will be happy to discuss any problems you may have.

### GENERAL

- The Kit Shop in Cobham Road, Fetcham stock all our uniform requirements. Items not requiring our logo may also be obtained from any other school uniform stockist, department store or supermarket
- Each child needs a drawstring bag, clearly named on the outside, in which to keep their PE kit. Each individual item **must be clearly named. PE kit and trainers are to be kept in school all week** and taken home to be washed as required. This gives the teacher flexibility with their PE lessons and enables them to take advantage of changes in timetable and weather conditions.
- Overalls, an apron or an old shirt should be provided to protect the child's school clothing for activities such as art, pottery and technology and should be kept in school at all times.
- **Children are not permitted to wear jewellery of any type.** If a child must wear earrings, they should either be small plain sleepers or studs and need to be removed for PE, games and swimming. If children are unable to remove their own earrings, they will not be allowed to take part in those activities for their own safety. It is for this reason that you are advised only to have your child's ears pierced at the start of the long summer holidays, so that they can be removed by the child once they are back in school.
- For swimming girls will need a one piece costume and boys must wear swimming trunks and not shorts. The swimming costume and towel (clearly named) must be brought to school on the appropriate day in a strong waterproof bag. Children with long hair should wear a swimming cap. Children with a verruca will not be allowed to use the pool unless they wear a protective plastic sock.
- Children may change into their trainers at play times and lunch times but they must change back into their black shoes on return to class.
- Children may not wear nail varnish and children with long hair will be required to wear it tied back away from their face all day. Children may not dye their hair or have hairstyles that are not appropriate for school activities.
- **All articles of clothing need to be named.** Forms for purchasing printed clothes labels are available from the school office.
- 'Nearly New' uniform is available for sale via the Friends of Eastwick Schools and regular sales are held after school.
