They were part of a team of ten children who represented the Leatherhead region of schools. They took part in events such as the Vortex Howler throw, long jump, sprint and 600m. INFLATABLE ASSAULT COURSE AND SLIDE!

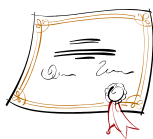
