#### IMPORTANT E-SAFETY UPDATE

Whilst the minimum age for SnapChat is 13, Mrs O'Brien felt it important to share with you an update to this mobile app that allows users to capture videos and pictures that self destruct after a few seconds. Last week SnapChat, used regularly by many children and young people, launched a new feature. SnapMaps allows users to see the location of their contacts. This feature allows others to accurately pinpoint where you are and there are three possible privacy settings:

- Ghost mode, where only you can see your position;
- My Friends mode, where any contact can see your location; and
- Select Friends mode, just those who you choose can see you

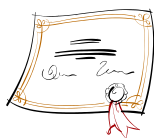
#### Stationery Sale
